

DYING GRACE

Acts 20:24 I do not consider my life as dear to myself, so that I may finish my race, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify of the gospel of the grace of God.

Colossians 1:4-6 We heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and the love which you have for all the saints; because of the hope laid up for you in heaven, of which you previously heard in the word of truth, the gospel which has come to you, just as in all the world also it is constantly bearing fruit and increasing, even as it has been doing in you also since the day you heard of it and understood the grace of God in truth.

1 Corinthians 10:31 Whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

1 Corinthians 15:36 That which you sow does not come to life unless it dies.

1 Corinthians 15:53-55 This perishable must put on the imperishable, and this mortal must put on immortality. But when this perishable will have put on the imperishable, and this mortal will have put on immortality, then will come about the saying that is written, death is swallowed up in victory. O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?

1 Corinthians 15:57 Thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:6-8 Knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord; for we walk by faith, not by sight; we are of good courage and prefer rather to be absent from the body and face to face with the Lord.

2 Corinthians 5:9 We also have as our ambition, whether at home or absent, to be pleasing to Him.

Ephesians 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ.

Ephesians 2:6-7 God raised us with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 11:20-21 By faith Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau, even regarding things to come. By faith Jacob, as he was dying, blessed each of the sons of Joseph, and worshipped.

Isaiah 30:18 The Lord longs to be gracious to you, and therefore He waits on high to have compassion on you. For the Lord is a God of justice; how blessed are all those who long for Him.

James 1:12 Happy is he who perseveres under testing; for having been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.

Psalm 116:15 Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His saints.

Revelation 14:13 I heard a voice from heaven, saying, write, blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on! Yes, says the Spirit, so that they may rest from their labors, for their deeds follow with them.

Revelation 21:4 He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away.

Romans 14:8 If we live, we live for the Lord; or if we die, we die for the Lord; therefore whether we live or die, we are the Lord's.
