

LIVING GRACE

Colossians 2:3 In Him are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

Colossians 4:5 Conduct yourselves with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of the opportunity.

1 Corinthians 2:5 Your faith should not rest on the wisdom of men, but on the power of God.

1 Corinthians 3:16 Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Holy Spirit dwells in you?

1 Corinthians 9:25-27 Everyone who competes in the games exercises self-control in all things. They then do it to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable. Therefore I run in such a way, as not without aim; I discipline my body and make it my slave, so that, I myself will not be disqualified.

1 Corinthians 15:10 By the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me did not prove vain; but I labored even more than all of them, yet not I, but the grace of God with me.

2 Corinthians 2:17 For we are not like many, peddling the word of God, but as from sincerity, but as from God, we speak in Christ in the sight of God.

2 Corinthians 4:15 All things are for your sakes, so that the grace which is spreading to the many, may cause the giving of thanks to abound to the glory of God.

2 Corinthians 9:7 Let each one give as he has purposed in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God honors a correctly motivated giver.

Luke 6:38 Give, and it will be given to you. They will pour into your lap a good measure - pressed down, shaken together, and running over. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return.

Luke 12:48 From everyone who has been given much, much will be required; and to whom they entrusted much, of him they will ask all the more.

Luke 23:34 Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing.

Matthew 6:33 Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

Matthew 11:29-30 Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.

2 Peter 3:18 Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory, both now and forever.

Philippians 4:19 God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

Proverbs 1:8-9 Hear your father's instruction and do not forsake your mother's teaching; indeed, they are a graceful wreath to your head and ornaments about your neck.

Proverbs 9:9-11 Give instruction to a wise man and he will be still wiser; teach a righteous man and he will increase his learning. Occupation with the Lord is the beginning of wisdom and knowledge of God is understanding. For by me your days will be multiplied and years of life will be added to you.

Proverbs 16:9 The mind of man plans his way but the Lord directs his steps.

Proverbs 19:20 Listen to counsel and accept discipline that you may be wise the rest of your days.

Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go, even when he is old he will not depart from it.

Proverbs 29:17 Correct your son and he will give you comfort; he will also delight your soul.

Psalms 23:1 The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.

Psalms 26:2 Examine me, O Lord, and try me; test my mind and my heart.

Psalms 32:8 I will instruct you and teach you in the way which you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you.
