Galatians 6:7 Do not be deceived, God will not be mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap.

Hebrews 1:2 God has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

Isaiah 43:25 I am He who wipes out your transgressions for My own sake, and I will not remember your sins.

Isaiah 51:8 My righteousness will be forever and My salvation to all generations.

Jeremiah 23:23-24 Am I a God who is near and not a God far off? Can a man hide himself in hiding places so I do not see him? Do I not fill the heavens and the earth? declares the Lord.

Job 11:7 Can you discover the depths of God? Can you discover the limits of the Almighty?

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word [Jesus Christ] and the Word was with God and the Word was God.

John 1:14 The Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only uniquely born from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 4:24 God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship Him in spirit and truth.

John 7:28 He who sent Me is true.

John 10:38 Believe My works that you may know and understand that the Father is in Me and I in the Father.

John 14:13-15 Whatever you ask in My name, that will I do, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask Me anything in My name, I will do it. If you love Me, you will keep My commandments.

Psalm 103:2 Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget none of His benefits.

Psalm 112:1 How blessed is the man who fears the Lord, who greatly delights in His mandates.

Psalm 117:2 His lovingkindness is great toward us, and the truth of the Lord is everlasting. Praise the Lord!

Psalm 118:23 This is the Lord's doing; it is marvelous in our eyes.

Psalm 118:24 This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.

Psalm 130:5 I wait for the Lord, my soul does wait, and in His word do I hope.

Psalm 136:1 Give thanks to the Lord for He is good, for His mercy endures forever.

Psalm 139:14 I will give thanks to You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made.

Psalm 147:5 Great is our Lord and abundant in strength; His understanding is infinite.

Revelation 1:8 I am the Alpha and the Omega [the Beginning and the End], says the Lord God, who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.

Romans 1:20 Since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse.
