James 4:7 Submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

Jeremiah 1:19 They will fight against you, but they will not overcome you, for I am with you to deliver you.

Jeremiah 32:27 Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh; is anything too difficult for Me?

Job 5:17-22 Happy is the man whom God reproves, so do not despise discipline. For He inflicts pain, and gives relief; He wounds, and His hands also heal. - Psalm 27:5 In the day of trouble He will conceal me in His tabernacle; in the secret place of His tent He will hide me; He will lift me up on a rock.
- Psalm 27:14 Wait for the Lord, be strong and let your heart take courage. Wait for the Lord.
- Psalm 28:7 The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in Him and I am helped; therefore my heart greatly rejoices.
- Psalm 31:3 You are my rock and my fortress; for Your name's sake You will lead me and guide me.
- Psalm 31:24 Be strong and let your heart take courage, all you who hope in the Lord.
- Psalm 32:7 You are my hiding place; You preserve me from trouble; You surround me with songs of deliverance.
- Psalm 33:20 Our soul waits for the Lord; He is our help and our shield.

Psalm 34:18-19 The Lord is near to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit. Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the Lord delivers him out of them all.

Psalm 40:1-3 I waited patiently for the Lord; and He inclined to me and heard my cry. He brought me up out of the pit of destruction, out of the miry clay, and He set my feet upon a rock making my footsteps firm. He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God; many will see and fear and will trust in the Lord.

Psalm 46:1 God is our refuge and strength; a very present help in trouble.

Psalm 50:15 Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I shall deliver you, and you will glorify Me.

Psalm 61:3 You are a refuge for me, a tower of strength against the enemy.

Psalm 62:6-7 He only is my rock and my salvation; He is my defense; I shall not be shaken. On God my salvation and my glory rest; the rock of my strength, my refuge is in God.

Psalm 71:5 For You are my hope; O Lord God, You are my confidence from my youth.

Psalm 91:2-3 I will say to the Lord, my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust! For it is He who delivers you from the snare of the trapper and from the deadly pestilence.

Psalm 91:4 He will cover you with His pinions, and under His wings you should take refuge; His faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Psalm 91:11-12 He will give His angels charge concerning you, to guard you in all your ways. They will bear you up in their hands that you do not strike your foot against a stone.

Psalm 121:1-2 I will lift up my eyes to the mountains; from where comes my help? My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth.

Psalm 121:7-8 The Lord will protect you from all evil; He will keep your soul. The Lord will guard your going out and your coming in from this time forth and forever.

Revelation 3:10 Because you have guarded the truth of Me, I will guard you in the hour of testing that is about to come.

Romans 5:1-2 Having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God.
