We call standing on God's promises using faith-rest. When you faith-rest a situation, you rely on God and His divine resources. Trusting God is your stability in life. His promises are your shield of faith to protect you from Satan's strategies and deceptions including human viewpoint thinking.

> Be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might. Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil ... In addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish the flaming arrows of the evil one. (Ephesians 6:10-16)

Let's begin with God's promise of salvation, *Believe in* the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved (Acts 16:31). If you have not made the decision on where you will spend eternity, do it now. In prayer, tell God the Father something such as, "I believe Your Son Jesus Christ died on the cross for me. I accept Him as my Savior." By this simple act of faith, you are saved. To use a promise within your shield of faith, first be sure you are filled with the Holy Spirit. This means you have no unconfessed sin in your life because you have used God's provision to handle personal sin. *If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9).*

Next, recall a promise from those you have memorized and stored in your soul. If the situation and time allow, select one from your list of favorites or a resource such as this book.

Then, claim the promise by expressing your thoughts to God the Father in prayer, reciting His promise to you. Thank Him for giving you this divine provision.

This is where God's promise of the ministry of the Holy Spirit takes effect. The Holy Spirit will help you recall relevant Biblical principles you have learned. Now you have divine viewpoint options to consider.

The final step is to mix your faith in God and His promise with a rationale from the Word of God, then come to a conclusion and apply it to the situation.

I pray you will find this compilation of some of God's promises useful as you advance in your spiritual life.

Acts 16:31 Believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved.

1 Corinthians 15:1-4 I make known to you, by which also you are saved ... that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures.

1 Corinthians 15:21-22 Since by a man [Adam] came death, by a man [Jesus Christ] also came the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all will be made alive.

2 Corinthians 5:17 If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things have passed away and all things have become new.

Galatians 4:7 You are no longer a servant but a son, and if a son, then an heir through Christ.

Hebrews 2:14-15 Since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, and might free those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives.

Isaiah 53:12 He Himself bore the sin of many and interceded for the transgressors.

John 1:12 As many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name.

John 3:3 Jesus said to him, Truly, truly I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world He gave His uniquely born Son that whoever believes in Him will not perish but have eternal life.

John 3:36 He who believes in the Son has eternal life; he who does not believe in the Son will not see life but the wrath of God abides on him.

1 Corinthians 3:16 Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Holy Spirit dwells in you?

1 Corinthians 9:25-27 Everyone who competes in the games exercises self-control in all things. They then do it to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable. Therefore I run in such a way, as not without aim; I discipline my body and make it my slave, so that, I myself will not be disqualified.

1 Corinthians 15:10 By the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me did not prove vain; but I labored even more than all of them, yet not I, but the grace of God with me.

2 Corinthians 2:17 For we are not like many, peddling the word of God, but as from sincerity, but as from God, we speak in Christ in the sight of God.

2 Corinthians 4:15 All things are for your sakes, so that the grace which is spreading to the many, may cause the giving of thanks to abound to the glory of God.

2 Corinthians 9:7 Let each one give as he has purposed in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God honors a correctly motivated giver.

Luke 12:48 From everyone who has been given much, much will be required; and to whom they entrusted much, of him they will ask all the more.

Luke 23:34 Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing.

Matthew 6:33 Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

Psalm 26:2 Examine me, O Lord, and try me; test my mind and my heart.

Psalm 27:11 Teach me Your way; lead me in a level path.

Psalm 28:8 The Lord is a saving defense to His anointed.

Psalm 32:5 I acknowledged my sin to You, and my iniquity I did not hide; I said, I will confess my transgressions to the Lord; and You forgave the guilt of my sin.

Psalm 32:8 I will instruct you and teach you in the way which you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you.

Psalm 48:14 Such is God, our God forever and ever; He will guide us until death.

Psalm 119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

Romans 4:20-21 With respect to the promise of God, he did not waver in unbelief but grew strong in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully assured that what God had promised, He was able also to perform.

Romans 8:37 In all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us.

Romans 10:17 Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God.

Romans 13:1-2 Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God and those which exist are established by God. Therefore whoever resists authority has opposed the ordinance of God; and they who have opposed will receive condemnation upon themselves.

Romans 13:5-6 Therefore it is necessary to be in subjection, not only because of wrath, but also for conscience' sake. For because of this you also pay taxes, for rulers are servants of God, devoting themselves to this very thing.

1 Timothy 4:8 For bodily discipline is only of little profit, but godliness [your spiritual life] is profitable for all things, since it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come.

1 Timothy 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith; take hold of the eternal life to which you were called.

2 Timothy 1:7 God has not given us a lifestyle of fear, but of power and love and sound judgment.

Psalm 23:4 Even though I walk through the deathshadowed valley, I will not fear harm, for You walk with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.

Psalm 34:22 The Lord redeems the soul of His servants, and none of those who trust in Him will be forsaken.

Psalm 71:18 Even when I am old and gray, O God, do not forsake me, until I declare Your strength to this generation, Your power to all who are to come.

Psalm 73:26 My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

Psalm 116:15 Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His saints.

Revelation 14:13 I heard a voice from heaven, saying, write, blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on! Yes, says the Spirit, so that they may rest from their labors, for their deeds follow with them.

Revelation 21:4 He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away.

Romans 14:8 If we live, we live for the Lord; or if we die, we die for the Lord; therefore whether we live or die, we are the Lord's.

2 Timothy 4:6-8 The time of my departure is at hand. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. There is laid up for me a crown of righteousness which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day; and not only to me, but also to all who have loved His appearing.

Colossians 1:5 The hope which is laid up for you in heaven, of which you heard before in the word of the truth, the gospel.

Colossians 3:23-24 Whatever you do, do it heartily as to the Lord and not to men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance, for you serve the Lord Christ.

1 Corinthians 2:9 Just as it is written, things which eye has not seen and ear has not heard, and which have not entered the heart of man, all that God has prepared for those who love Him.

1 Corinthians 13:12 Now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face; now I know in part, but then I will know fully.

1 Corinthians 15:42-44 So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown a perishable body, it is raised an imperishable body; it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power; it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body.

2 Corinthians 4:14 Knowing that He who raised the Lord will raise us also with Jesus and will present us with you.

2 Corinthians 5:1 We know that if the earthly tent which is our house is torn down, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

Deuteronomy 30:6 The Lord your God will circumcise your heart to love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, so that you may live.

Ephesians 1:14 Who [God the Holy Spirit] is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of God's own possession, to the praise of His glory.

Ephesians 1:18-21 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of the strength of His might which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come.

Ephesians 4:30 Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

Galatians 5:1 It was for freedom that Christ set us free; therefore keep standing firm and do not be subject again to a yoke of slavery [legalism].

Hebrews 6:17-19 In the same way God, desiring even more to show to the heirs of the promise the unchangeableness of His purpose, interposed with an oath, so that by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us. This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, a hope both sure and steadfast.

John 10:28-29 I give eternal life to them and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of My hand. My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand.

John 14:2-3 I go to prepare a place for you. If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also.

1 John 2:25 This is the promise which He Himself made to us, eternal life.

1 John 3:1-2 See how great a love the Father has bestowed on us, that we would be called children of God; and such we are. For this reason the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is.

1 John 5:5 Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

1 John 5:11-13 The testimony is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life. These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life.

1 Peter 1:3-5 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to obtain an inheritance which is incorruptible and undefiled, that fades not away, reserved in heaven for us who are protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

1 Peter 3:18 Christ also died for sins once for all, the just for the unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit.

Philippians 3:10 That I may know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His suffering.

Romans 8:11 He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through the Holy Spirit who dwells in you.

ETERNAL SECURITY

Romans 8:38-39 I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, will be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

2 Samuel 12:22-23 He [David] said, while my infant son was still alive I fasted and wept; for I said, who knows whether the Lord will be gracious to me that my child may live? But now that he has died, why should I fast? Can I bring him back? [No] I will go to him [in heaven] but he will not return to me.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-14 Do not grieve as those who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus Christ died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus.

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 The Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord.

1 Thessalonians 5:8 Let us be self-controlled, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet, the hope of salvation.

2 Timothy 2:13 Even if we become faithless, God remains faithful because He cannot deny Himself.

2 Timothy 4:18 The Lord will deliver me from every evil work and will bring me safely to His heavenly kingdom.

A shallow soul produces a shallow faith.

Adversity is inevitable. Stress is optional.

Adversity is what circumstances do to you. Stress is what you do to yourself.

Affliction is allowed to accelerate spiritual growth, develop patience, increase trust in God and glorify Him.

Affliction will rearrange your thinking, if you let it.

Are you a risk taker or an excuse maker? Get in the boat and follow Jesus Christ.

Arrogance: Self-justification leads to self-deception followed by self-absorption ending with self-destruction.

Arrogance reacts. Humility responds.

Arrogant people have unrealistic self-images and unrealistic expectations.

Articulate, don't speculate.

As goes your spiritual life, so goes your nation.

As long as you are alive, God still has a plan for you.

Authority is not always fair, neither is life.

Bad decisions limit future options.

Bake in the Lake of Fire forever or live in the presence of God in heaven forever - your choice.

Be laconic.

Being happy depends on how you use your volition.

Blessings come and blessings go, the Source remains the same.

Christianity is a personal relationship with God, not a religion.

Circumstances are your pulpit; use them to glorify God.

Contentment brings capacity for life, love and happiness.

Counsel yourself with God's Word.

Divine discipline is intended to get your attention.

Divine viewpoint thinking resists the lures of the world.

Don't audit the Christian life.

Don't bend to the demands of the world and don't blend God's Word to meet your desires.

Don't humanize God.

Don't let the good things of life take you from the best things of life.

Don't try to make money off of God.

Doubt is the absence of faith.

Emotionalism leads to faulty thinking.

Essential or non-essential? Evaluate distractions.

Every Christian is given a time and a standard; redeem the time and live up to the standard.

Every problem has a solution stated in the Bible.

3 F's you need when you get to heaven (2 Timothy 4:7): I Fought ... I Finished ... I Kept the Faith.

Faith is spiritual stamina.

Fear and your spiritual life are not compatible.

Fear of dying inhibits living.

Fear sees the problem. Faith sees the solution.

Forgiveness process: Forgive the person. Forget the deed. Move on.

God answers prayer in His timing, not yours.

God designed you to think, not emote.

God expects you to represent Jesus Christ through your thoughts and actions and to re-present Him to others.

God gave you two ends - one to think with and one to sit on. Success in life depends on which end you use. Heads you win - Tails you lose.

God leaves you here for a purpose, His.

God speaks to you through His Word, the Bible.

God uses prepared Christians.

God wants you to be faithful not flawless.

God will never throw you under the bus.

God's direction may take you where you don't want to go.

God's plan is perfect and His timing is perfect.

God's Word is the antidote for anxiety.

God's Word is the fuel to grow your faith.

Grace is God's policy. Grace is God doing all the work.

Grace is neither earned nor deserved.

Gritching doesn't glorify the Lord.

Growing old is inevitable. Growing up is optional.

Happiness does not depend on people or circumstances.

Happiness is a state of mind.

Have you ever asked God for an assignment?

Having money just gives you the ability to be miserable in a different part of town.

Holding on to the past is a waste of time.

Human solutions are no solutions. Divine solutions are the only solutions.

Human viewpoint thinking is stinkin' thinkin'.

Humility gives you true perspective.

Humility is teachability.

If God is in it, He will pay for it.

If Satan can influence your thoughts, he can control you.

If you are afraid of dying, you are afraid to live.

If you are not advancing spiritually, you are regressing.

If you attend a church where the song service is longer than the teaching of God's Word, you're getting gypped.

If you don't arm your soul with the Word of God, you are a sitting duck in the angelic conflict.

If you don't use rebound, God's other problem-solving devices won't work.

In affliction it's okay to pray for yourself but once is enough; don't try to manipulate God in prayer.

In living, you apply God's Word; in dying, you live it.

It's never too late to make a course correction in life.

It's never too late to rebound, reconsider your ways or relocate to get under the teaching of a qualified pastor.

It's not our job to straighten out the devil's world.

Jesus Christ controls history.

Keep the outside sources of adversity from becoming stress in your soul by using God's problem-solving devices. This is your FLOT line (Forward Line of Troops) in your soul.

Keep these three aligned: the Witness of God's Word, Witness of Circumstances and Witness of the Holy Spirit.

LAG - Learn God's Word. Apply it. Grow to spiritual maturity and Glorify God.

Learn to appreciate the grace of God.

Learning Scripture is like peeling an onion; it's layered.

Leave your agenda behind and walk in God's unique plan.

Life is a journey; God's Word is the guide.

Live life in the light of eternity.

Man looks on the outside; God looks on the inside.

Many people don't understand the God they know.

Many people spend money they don't have, to buy things they don't need, to impress people they don't even like.

Most suffering is self-induced - we mismanage our money, our health or our relationships.

Much of our activity is nothing but a cheap narcotic to deaden the pain of an empty life.

MVP - A spiritual MVP has Momentum, Virtue and Poise. Momentum from hearing and keeping God's Word on a daily basis. Virtue from discernment and insight of divine wisdom. Poise from the ability to think under pressure.

Never build your happiness on someone else's unhappiness.

Never make a critical decision without considering God's will; pray for guidance.

Norms and standards are designed to protect you.

Now is the time to prepare for old age.

Objective optimism is a characteristic of resiliency.

Once saved – Always saved.

Only God's Word helps others, not sharing your tragedies.

Patience and humility are learned spiritual skills.

People with OPDs (obnoxious personality disorders): respond to them with an attitude of impersonal love.

Personal love for God is your motivation to execute the spiritual life.

Prayer is incredibly powerful; use it correctly and boldly.

Prayer is not a problem-solving device.

Prioritize your relationship with God over your relationships with people.

Priority or Passion? Put your priorities ahead of your passions.

Production is a result of spiritual advancement, not the cause.

Recognize providential circumstances; wait on God's lead and go through open doors.

Redeem the time. Tomorrow is not guaranteed.

Resist your three enemies: the world, the flesh (your sin nature) and the devil.

Respond to divine discipline; let it lead you back to God's plan.

Right thinking leads to right motives and right actions.

Ritual without reality is meaningless.

Satan never quits. The cosmic system never rests.

Satan's system is human good and evil.

Scripture gives you the ability to see the unknown.

Seize opportunities to present the gospel.

Soul strength is more important than physical strength.

Spiritual maturity is a process; it isn't an end state.

Spiritual maturity is relative; it's based on the filling of the Holy Spirit and the content of God's Word in your soul.

Spiritual skills are acquired, not inherited.

Spiritual skills must precede production skills.

Spirituality is a position, an absolute. You are either filled with the Holy Spirit or under control of your sin nature.

Stay off the My Way Highway.

Stay out of Christian activism.

Stick with the truth of God's Word; don't be recruited by the cosmic system.

Store up God's Word in your soul and you will be rich.

Tap into the prevailing power of persistent prayer.

Testing gives you data to assess your spiritual condition.

Testing is a means to get you where you need to be.

Testing is designed to build spiritual muscle.

Testing often comes in your area of weakness.

The Bible is not a novel; it is a textbook. God designed it to be taught accurately by a qualified pastor.

The choices you make determine the life you lead.

The Christian life demands mechanics called the protocol plan of God; a right thing must be done in a right way.

The Christian way of life is not activity or productivity; it is conductivity transmitting God's grace to others.

The Fantastic Four (Proverbs 2:10-11): Wisdom ... Knowledge ... Discretion ... Understanding.

The greatest virtues in life are personal love for God and impersonal love for others.

The Holy Spirit is your escort through time to eternity.

The mind games of aging are won in the soul.

The public lie is to tell it often enough and loud enough and people will believe it.

The rate of learning must exceed the rate of forgetting.

The spiritual life is a process.

The spiritual must take precedence over the physical.

The Supreme Court of Heaven is open 24/7. Let God handle the justice. He has all the facts.

The will of God will never lead you to where the grace of God can't protect you.

The Word of God is a mirror; use it to assess your life.

There is no adversity too great for the plan of God.

There is no reason for a Christian to ever be unhappy.

There is no shortcut to learning the Word of God.

There is real danger in experimenting with things the world offers.

Think grace and demonstrate grace.

Three checkpoints for knowing the directive will of God: Where does God want me to be? What does God want me to think? What does God want me to do?

Time doesn't shout, it just runs out, sooner than you think.

Time is a gift from God.

Today we have too many preacher-performers and not enough pastor-teachers.

Treat people based on your character, not theirs.

Unhappy people take their unhappiness with them wherever they go.

Use Scripture; it worked for the Lord Jesus Christ, it will work for you.

Wait on God's timing; don't be impetuous.

What God thinks of you is what counts, not the opinions of others.

What impresses people is what's in your soul.

When treated unfairly, do you respond with humility or react with arrogance?

When you don't have enough on the inside to offset the pressures from the outside, you will be crushed.

Where do you get your direction in life - from the Word of God or from your friends?

Winners execute. Losers emote.

WOJs (weird obnoxious jerks): respond to them with an attitude of impersonal love.

Worry is assuming unassigned responsibilities.

Worship the Giver, not the gifts.

You are a divinely appointed spiritual influencer.

You are in full time Christian service. Be a quiet spiritual professional.

You are never alone; God is with you, always.

You are never too old to stop learning God's Word.

You are the product of your decisions, not your circumstances.

You are what you think, not what you think you are.

You can't apply what you don't know.

You can't grow if you don't know.

You can't grow to spiritual maturity on your own.

You can't know the will of God apart from knowing the Word of God.

You don't need to tell God your problems, He knows. Thank Him for the solutions.

You have total control over the development of your soul.

You trust God with your life, trust Him with the details.

Your body may be racked by time but your soul is timeless.

Your home is in heaven; you are just a sojourner here.

Your soul manifests the real you.

Your soul never grows old.

Your spiritual gift is given by God to serve Him; your talent is different.

Your spiritual life is lived in the mentality of your soul.
